

## **MOUNTIE BASKETBALL CAMP 2010**

**WHO:** All boys and girls currently in **grades 4 through 8**. Registration is on a first come first served basis. Many years camp has “filled up” and players were turned away, so register early. Camp is open to all regional players.

**WHEN:** Mountie Camp will be held **MONDAY, June 14, 2010 through FRIDAY, June 18, 2009**. Camp hours are 8:45 AM until 3:30 PM. The gym will be open between the hours of 8 AM and 4 PM to help accommodate parents’ work schedule as well as for campers who want to spend extra time developing their skills. **PLEASE plan on picking your child up by 4 PM—the coaches will be leaving at that time.**

**WHERE:** Stroudsburg Junior High School will be the location of camp this year. Both outside and inside facilities will be used. Campers need to be prepared for the outside elements of **heat** (bring a towel and water bottle), **sun** (bring sunscreen) and the possibility of **rain**.

**CAMPER NEEDS:** All campers need to bring a bag lunch with their name clearly marked on the outside (all lunches will be stored in coolers). Water bottles (many bring the bottle full of ice to start the day) and a towel are also necessary. Make sure the camper’s name is clearly visible on both. Drinks will be provided all day at camp. We suggest sunscreen as mentioned above. Of course, **comfortable layered clothing** (it may start out cool in the morning and get very warm in the afternoon) and **good basketball shoes** are musts.

Many campers must leave early or at various other times for other activities or appointments. A note must be given to the coach on the morning the player is leaving and we ask that the person picking the player up come into the gym to get them.

**ACTIVITIES:** Camp is designed to help players develop all aspects of their game, but there will be a strong emphasis on becoming a better shooter. Campers will be taped while shooting and then critiqued by a coach. Players will spend time in a variety of different stations (all designed to improve the developing player), drills that build their skills and playing games each day.

Several speakers have been recruited to talk with the campers about ways to become better athletes. In the past, Scott Coval, DeSales University Coach and Bob Salmi, former Wizards assistant coach and current basketball announcer for ESPN have spoken. We have also been fortunate in the past to have Dave Hopla put on his famous ‘Shooting Show’ for the campers.

Friday afternoon will have the final competitions for the different skills awarded and this will be followed by a ceremony in which family members are invited. Each camper will receive an evaluation from their coach on their strengths and areas they need to improve upon.

**COACHING STAFF:** This year's staff will be comprised of local junior high and high school coaches. We also have several former players that are now playing in college and a few that have graduated from college returning to coach. We supplement this staff with current high school players who assist our team coaches.

**COST:** The cost this year will be **one hundred thirty-five dollars (\$135.00)**. If you have two or more siblings attending, there is a five-dollar reduction, making the cost one hundred thirty dollars (\$130.00). This is the same price as last year. A **deposit of sixty-five dollars (\$65.00)** should accompany the registration form. The seventy dollar (\$70.00) [or sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) if you are sending two or more] **balance is due Monday, June 14th AT REGISTRATION**. ALL CHECKS SHOULD BE MADE OUT TO **SMSBBC**. (Of course it is fine to pay the total when sending in the form, if it is easier than having the campers bring it with them on the first day.)

**DEADLINES:** The form on the next page should accompany the sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) down payment. When camp reaches its capacity, no more players will be accepted. Unless you are notified that camp is "full", YOU WILL RECEIVE NO OTHER COMMUNICATION REGARDING CAMP. Monday, June 15th, beginning at 8 AM campers may arrive in the lobby of the Stroudsburg Junior High School, sign in and pay their balance.

**HOW TO REGISTER:** If the camper is a Stroudsburg student: in a sealed envelope, the form on the next page and the deposit can be given to:
